Back Towards Normal...

As Georgia relaxes the stay at home orders, Northside Pediatrics plans to start seeing kids of all ages for check-ups, while still prioritizing social distancing and safety.

- 1. IN THE MORNING ONLY, well children will be seen. Check-ups for newborns, 2 weeks olds and 2 month olds must be done during the morning session.
- 2. **IN THE AFTERNOON**, well visits for all ages will be seen on one side of the office. Sick visits will be on the other side of the office, with a dedicated provider performing only sick visits. Sick patients will be kept in their rooms for the duration of the visit, including any lab work.
- 3. **TO LIMIT YOUR TIME IN THE OFFICE:** An NSP clinical staff member will call your family the day before your well visit to gather necessary information, including nutrition, development and sports screen.
- 4. TO AVOID GROUPS IN THE WAITING ROOM: All patients will wait in their cars until called by clinical staff to come directly back to the room.
- 5. ALL patients will check in and pay online via NSP's check in platform Phressia.
- 6. <u>ALL</u> patients and family members > 2 years old will be asked to wear a mask (PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN MASK).
- 7. MASKS and GOGGLES will be worn by all NSP staff for all visits.
- 8. **TELEMEDICINE** visits will be available in the afternoon, and ideal for medication checks and some sick visits, such as rashes.
- 9. We are offering priority visits to kids whose visits were <u>canceled</u> due to sheltering in place.
